




# VOGUE THEATRE

On December 7, 2013 the greater Manistee area witnessed the rebirth of the Historic Vogue Theatre. Previously vacant for nearly a decade, the Vogue is the product of nearly five years of strong vision, determined passion and abundant generosity of this community's residents and businesses.

As the 501c3 non-profit organization that oversaw the revitalization of our local cinema, the Historic Vogue Theatre of Manistee (HVTM) has successfully operated the Vogue since that rebirth in late 2013. We are extremely proud to be able to bring the best and biggest movies to Manistee as well as offer a slew of special events to all who live in and visit our beautiful community.



We take pride in our diverse programming at the Vogue.

- Of the twenty feature films nominated for 2015 Academy Awards in the major categories (best picture, director, screenplay, the acting categories and cinematography) the Vogue showed 90% of the nominees.

- All fifteen Oscar-nominated short films were screened as well.



- Of the top fifteen highest-grossing films (nationwide) of 2015, the Vogue presented all but one during their initial release!

We welcomed the film to sold-out crowds during its run, and held a special screening featuring a panel discussion, meet & greet and autograph session with cast and crew members from near and far.

Manistee native Clinton Trucks produced the award-winning documentary 'Call Me Lucky' (directed by Bobcat Goldthwait) and held a special hometown screening at the Vogue during the film's festival run throughout the country. The powerful documentary subsequently picked up a national distribution deal.

In an effort to raise awareness of teenage homelessness, West Michigan native Kirsten Kelly presented her film 'The Homestretch' followed by a panel discussion with local service providers and Kirsten herself (from New York) via Skype!



We showcase our commitment to bring the best in cinematic programming to all with our myriad of free and nearly-free opportunities.


Every Saturday morning is a different family-friendly film for only 25cents per ticket.

Attendance at the Vogue - and with it ticket revenues - have steadily increased since we opened our doors.


It took exactly one year to hit our first 50,000 patron milestone - and we passed 100,000 patrons under nine months later!



#### Concessions Sales By Month




# It's Working.

Month after month is consistently "in the black" at the Vogue. We meet all of our operational expenses with our sales revenue. By consistently providing a top-notch experience and keeping expenses in check, our non-profit downtown cinema isn't just working. It's thriving.

Taking into account all sources of revenue (including grants and donations) and all spending (including capital expenditures, debt service and depreciation) our increase in net assets for 2015 was \$115,044

60% The amount of our \$100,000 emergency reserve fund we have already set aside.
